<b>Samuel Beytin Fallsburg Community Scholarship</b>	Fallsburg	Since 1952, Fallsburg High School seniors have been eligible to win a very special scholarship sponsored by the Fallsburg Teachers' Association. From the donations of teachers and other members of the community, the fund now gives a scholarship to worthy seniors to help defray costs at an undergraduate college or university. This scholarship has provided hundreds of thousands of dollars over the years. Our scholarship program is unique. Nowhere else in New York State is there a program on record of such tremendous proportions.
<b>Edward Bryan Memorial Scholarship</b>	Fallsburg	Established by the Charles Bryan family in honor of their son, a Fallsburg High School graduate.
<b>Candy Gold Memorial Scholarship</b>	Fallsburg	Funded by the Gold family to honor their daughter.
<b>Esthyr Mintz Flannagan Memorial Scholarship</b>	Fallsburg	In loving memory, honor and respect for Sarah and Isidor Mintz, former residents of South Fallsburg. Their daughter, Esthyr Mintz Flanagan, has made the award possible through a generous contribution.
<b>Milton Brizel Scholarship</b>	Fallsburg	Established in 2007 by the Brizel family in his memory. Mr. Brizel was a long-time educator in both the Fallsburg School District and Sullivan County Community College.
<b>Blossom Cohen Memorial Scholarship</b>	Fallsburg	In memory of longtime Benjamin Cosor Elementary teacher Blossom Cohen. Awarded by the Fallsburg Teachers' Association to a female senior who will be majoring in education or science.
<b>Hertz-LaRuffa Scholarship</b>	Fallsburg	The Irving Hertz Scholarship was instituted in 1959 in memory of Irving Hertz, a member of the Fallsburg Central School Faculty. Irving Hertz was a music teacher who was always involved with the students. He was extremely well liked by all people because of his unselfish contributions to the school and community. The President of the Senior Band has been designated chairperson of the fund drive for the scholarships. Since its inception, hundreds of scholarships have been awarded to worthy seniors who plan to continue their education. In 1983, the scholarship became the Hertz-LaRuffa Scholarship in honor of Joseph LaRuffa, who was band director for 30 years and was a moving force in making the Fallsburg Bands superior in all respects.

<b>Seymour and Minnie Feldman Memorial Scholarship</b>	Fallsburg	This scholarship is presented in memory of Seymour and Minnie Feldman, lifelong and devoted residents of the Town of Fallsburg by their children. Awarded to a graduating senior with an excellent record of community involvement and volunteering.
<b>Marion &amp; Philip Salon Memorial Scholarship</b>	Fallsburg	Lifelong residents of Hurleyville, Marion and Phil Salon were the owners and operators of a bungalow colony and Salon Corners, a convenience store. Their scholarship is designated for a graduating senior who plans to attend a four-year college and has demonstrated a sincere interest in public service and has participated in meaningful community service activities, or who has overcome a significant personal challenge during his or her school career. The memorial scholarship is supported by the Salons' children, relatives and friends.
<b>Kiwanis Club of Woodridge, NY (In memory of Dr. Mark Ruderman)</b>	Fallsburg	Awarded by the Kiwanis Club to seniors who demonstrate outstanding service to the school.
<b>Fallsburg Alumni Award</b>	Fallsburg	Established in 2006 by the Fallsburg Alumni Association. It is given to a senior who demonstrates scholarship and excellent character.
<b>Robynne Anderman-Pacheco Memorial Scholarship</b>	Fallsburg	Given to honor the memory of Robynne, a Fallsburg alumnus who taught at BCES for many years. It is awarded to a student who demonstrates good character, compassion to others, good academics, and some talent in music and the Arts. Funded by Arlene Hussey and Family.
<b>Sheryl Kalter Memorial Scholarship</b>	Fallsburg	Sheryl Kalter, a 1990 FCHS graduate, who went on to receive her doctorate in Pharmacy at the Massachusetts College of Pharmacy died at age 36. The recipient of this award must have emulated the characteristics so important to Sheryl: leadership, sensitivity, determination, a love and respect for all humanity and an abiding desire to help people. <b>Jack Leshner Scholarship</b>	Fallsburg	Jack Leshner, is a retired Fallsburg Social Studies teacher and member of the Fallsburg Hall of Fame. <b>Timothy Hill Memorial Scholarship</b>	Fallsburg	Established in 2009 in memory of Tim Hill, a Fallsburg alumnus, lifelong Woodbourne resident and politically active member of the community. Awarded to a senior who has performed community service and/or planning a career in public service.
<b>Resnick Group Scholarship</b>	Fallsburg	The Resnick Group is proud to offer a scholarship to a worthy High School Senior seeking to begin a career in business. Established by business man Daniel "Butch" Resnick, the scholarship is intended to assist a student with drive and who exhibits a commitment to his or her community and family. The scholarship is based upon the student's overall record of achievement in public service, scholastic accomplishment and personal job performance. Butch Resnick is a lifelong resident of Fallsburg growing up in Mountandale, NY and has shown a commitment to the economic improvement of the Fallsburg community. He hopes this scholarship can enable other young adults to join him in making the Fallsburg community a better place.

<b>Fallsburg Fire Department &amp; Rescue Squad Scholarship</b>	Fallsburg	Awarded to a graduate who will be pursuing a career in community service, including firematics, law-enforcement, or medical services. Good citizenship, moral character, academic achievement and community service commitment is also important.
<b>Coach Mike Weiner Scholarship</b>	Fallsburg	Awarded to a senior who is a student/athlete. Mr. Weiner, Fallsburg HS social studies teacher and coach of 30 years emphasizes grades, dedication and resiliency. Applicant must have an overall 80+ average throughout HS, a minimum of 40 community service hours, participate in student government for 2 or more years and be a role model on and off the field. Additionally the student should have overcome some type of major physical obstacle or family situation that happened while attending high school.
<b>Elissa Lippen/Matthew Helm Memorial Scholarship</b>	Fallsburg	In memory of Matthew Helm and Elissa Lippen, class of 1991 given to a senior who furthers his or her education in the arts and/or human services, displays good character and service to the school and/or community.
<b>Mel Mednick Memorial Scholarship</b>	Fallsburg	Established in 2009 in memory of Mel Mednick, longtime member of the Fallsburg faculty and Board of Education. Awarded to a senior who has been involved in community service and is actively involved in his/her class.



<b>Jocelyn Levner-Nissenbaum Memorial Scholarship</b>	Fallsburg	This scholarship was created by the family and friends of Jocelyn Levner-Nissenbaum who valiantly fought breast cancer with grace and dignity. Jocelyn, a proud graduate of Fallsburg Jr./Sr. High School and SUNY Geneseo, was a speech pathologist who dedicated her life to working with children. This scholarship is awarded to a graduate planning a career in speech pathology or another field working with children.
<b>Lucille S. Pantel Home Economics Award</b>	Fallsburg	This award was established by Mrs. Pantel and continues to be awarded by the Pantel Family in her memory. Lucille Pantel was a passionate home economics teacher, dedicated Fallsburg Central School Board member, Fallsburg Library founder, and active community citizen. This award is granted to a graduating senior pursuing a career in Family and Consumer Sciences, Library Science, or a senior who has volunteered in the school or local library. The recipient will be chosen by the Pantels upon the recommendation of the guidance counselor. Once verification of enrollment and Student ID# is submitted to the FCS Office of Guidance, the Pantels will be notified and the disbursement of the award will be sent to the educational institution and credited to the student's account.
<b>Haddon C. Pantel Memorial Scholarship</b>	Fallsburg	The Haddon C. Pantel Memorial Scholarship was established in 1974 in memory of Haddon Pantel, a Fallsburg alumnus and business person. The recipient of this award must be a graduating senior attending an accredited school to pursue a trade. Upon the recommendation of the guidance counselor, the recipient will be chosen by a review committee. Once verification of enrollment and student ID# is submitted to the FCS Office of Guidance, the committee will be notified and the disbursement of the award will be sent to the educational institution and credited to the student's account.

<b>NYS Award for Academic Excellence</b>	New York State	Awarded to seniors graduating near the top of their graduating class by the State Education Department.
<b>Triple C Award</b>	New York State	Awarded by Attorney to two students who display courage, character and commitment to themselves and their education.
<b>Association of Fire Districts of the State of NY- Ned Carter Memorial Scholarship</b>	New York State	Awarded to a high school senior who will be attending a two or four year college upon graduation and is also related to a firefighter, be a firefighter, related to a Fire District Administrator/Manager or be an Explorer in a fire department of a Fire District that is currently a paid member of the Association of Fire Districts of the State of New York.
<b>American Society of Civil Engineers Mohawk-Hudson Section</b>	New York State	Awarded to a high school senior who has chosen to pursue civil engineering.
<b>Epilepsy Foundation of Northeastern New York Scholarship</b>	New York State	Awarded to graduating high school seniors who are currently being treated for epilepsy and have plans to further their education.
<b>Colonel Augustus van Horne Ellis Memorial Annual Scholarship</b>	New York State	Awarded to a high school senior who demonstrates academic achievement, a record of performance in school and community activities, and an interest in the heritage of the United States.
<b>Cristin Ann Bambino Memorial Scholarship</b>	New York State	Awarded to a college-bound special education student to reward him or her for working through special challenges to complete high school and obtain acceptance to a college or university.
<b>Joseph Goncalves Student Humanitarian Scholarship</b>	New York State	Awarded to a graduating senior who plans to attend college in New York State. Students should be able to demonstrate a record of involvement and work for a cause or organization that actively promotes social justice, equal opportunity, relief of human suffering or similar aspirations generally understood to be within the meaning of humanitarian activity.
