## SUPERINTENDENL'S CORNER

Dear School Community Member:

hope this issue of the newsletter finds you in the best of health and spirit as the summer season is finally arriving. The 2017-18 budget season resulted in budget and building project propositions that passed on May 16th. On behalf of the Fallsburg Central School District I would like to thank the school community for continuing to support us!

#### The Board of Education

Congratulations to Renee Kates who won a seat on the Board of Education. Joe Collura and Kathy Rappaport won their seats as well and will continue serving as Board of Education members. A special thank you goes out to Ann Benson who served as a board member for the past several years. We wish Ann success in her future endeavors.

#### **Budget Update**

The approved budget for the 2017-18 school year is \$43,123,663. This is the budget number that the public voted on and approved on May 16th. The tax levy that goes along with this budget number is a 1.99% (\$377,902) increase over the previous tax levy. To get to this number the

Board applied \$1,687,128 from the general fund towards the tax levy to keep it low enough to support an increase of 1.99%. A state aid increase of \$466,151 in the approved State Budget helped us moderate the tax levy increase.

#### **Building Project Update**

On May 16th, the public voted on and approved a building project that will cost \$15.9 million dollars. We are anticipating that we will receive New York State building aid at a minimum of 73.9%. This means that we would get about 74 cents back on each dollar spent on the building project. Because we are receiving such high aid back from the State, the \$15.9 milliondollar project will ultimately cost taxpayers about \$8.5 million dollars (which is the net local share of \$5.6 million plus the total interest less total state aid over the life of the loan).

On June 13th, the building project Board committee continued the planning process with a kickoff meeting. The purpose of the meeting was to set the stage for the process moving forward. Construction is set to take place over two summers. The first summer of work will begin in July of 2018 and the project will conclude at the end of August

2019. Between now and the summer of 2018, all the background work will take place to set the stage for construction to begin. It will take several months to create capital project documentation that will be followed by approvals from the New York State Education Department (NYSED). The wait for approval from NYSED is approximately 30 weeks from the time of submission. Once we receive approval from NYSED, then we can put the project out to bid and award contracts. This should all be completed for construction to begin in July of 2018. I will continue to keep you posted as the project progresses.

#### The Class of 2017

Finally, I would like to take a moment to congratulate the graduating class of 2017. Graduation day will be their special time to step over the threshold of high school and walk into a new world beyond the schoolhouse gate. On behalf of the Fallsburg Central School District I wish the graduating class of 2017 all the success that they wish for themselves






#### **BCES Talent Show**

### FCSD Introduces Dual Language Program at Annual ENL Event

Fallsburg Central School District teachers of English as a new language (ENL) hosted their annual English Language Learner Expo for parents and families of students on June 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2017 in the BCES cafeteria.

During the evening, Assistant Superintendent of Instruction Dr. Matthew Evans, with translation from ENL teacher Mrs. Martha Zalkin, informed parents about an exciting, new Dual Language Program (DLP) coming to FCSD this fall. New York State Education Department (NYSED) supports this program.

Intended for kindergarten and first grade students, one DLP class in English and one in Spanish will alternate days in each grade. The classes will be continuous - that is, the lesson the second day will build on the lesson of the prior day throughout the semester. The kindergarten teachers will be

Mrs. Veronica Serrano in the Spanish class; Mr. Scott Persten in the English class; in first grade will be Mrs. Jeannette Espinoza in Spanish; and Mr. Dominick Scanna in English.

During his presentation, Dr. Evans highlighted the benefits of bilingual education in a young student's learning. Participating students will develop literacy skills in English and Spanish. Bilingual children show improved cognition in brain skills. Adults with bilingual skills have greater work opportunities and earn more money.

Catholic Charities offered special thanks to Kristt Company for their continued support, to the many students who participated, and to the school staff, parents, and all those who encouraged them.


