Larry Gainen has been inducted into the Binghamton University Athletic Hall of Fame. Larry performed on the Binghamton basketball and golf teams from 1965-1968, though it was in the sport of basketball that he excelled. A lefty and a 1964 graduate of Fallsburg High School he lettered in basketball and was a first team all-league selection his senior year. He won the Athlete of the Year Award and was a first team selection by the Times Herald Record. Larry cut his basketball teeth playing summers in the competitive Catskill Mountain resorts. Larry also competed for four seasons on the BU golf team. He was named the University's Athlete of the year for 1967-68 and the basketball player of the year in both his junior and senior years.



An economics major, he graduated magna cum laude and following nomination by then-President Bruce Dearing and athletic director, David Henderson, made the final cut in the Rhodes Scholarship competition. After a three-year teaching and coaching career at Fallsburg HS, he attended New York University Law School and went on to practice law in New York City.
