
As we prepare for September, I am excited about the opportunities that lie ahead.

On May 24, 2023, the Fallsburg Central School District hosted its 73rd annual Samuel Beytin Scholarship Award Dinner.

Graduating seniors, Aisha Darboe, Najuwa Ladan, Laura Marguez Vasguez, Kavalah Brewster, Isabella Frunzi, Andrew Rein Jr, Cyriah Russell, Samantha Medina Garzon, and Nicholas Muscia, were awarded scholarships for their high academic achievement, potential for success, and commitment to serving their community.

The scholarship dinner is a long-cherished tradition for the district. It began when a small group of Fallsburg teachers in 1951 decided that a scholarship fund was necessary to help local students fund higher education costs. This endeavor led to the creation of the Fallsburg Central Community Scholarship Fund (later named in honor of former Fallsburg Teacher, Samuel Beytin).

The scholarship fund is considered unique for New York State. It is paid through interest or donations and managed by a Board of Trustees consisting of teachers, administrators, the PTA, and community members.

"To get to this evening, our entire school community has played a part; teaching, guiding, supporting, and watching our students grow into the young adults they are becoming," said Superintendent of Schools, Dr. Ivan Katz. "I would like to thank the scholarship committee members who undertake ongoing efforts to raise money, to plan for this annual event, and to make it possible for students, each year, to take with them scholarship funds that help to offset the very expensive college costs that exist today."
