COMMUNITY: The district is comprised of 8 small villages scattered throughout a rural area. The main industries center around weekend and vacation homes. In addition, many people are employed at two New York State Corrections Facilities and health related services. Our school is approximately 95 miles from New York City.

SCHOOL: Our school building opened in September of 1958, an addition was added in 1992, can accommodate 500 students in grades 9-12. A second addition was added in 2001. Our library has in excess of 11,000 volumes and our faculty consists of 60 teachers, 1 librarian, 1 school nurse, 3 counselors, 2 psychologists and 3 social workers.

RANK IN CLASS AND GPA: Cumulative average is calculated by averaging the final marks of those courses required for graduation. Rank in class is determined by ranking the cumulative averages. Classes are weighted on a 1.05 scale if they are College and/or AP courses. The passing grade is 65%.

CURRICULA: Comprehensive High School program with sequential courses available in all college preparatory subjects as well as in art, music, business, and technology. Twenty-two credits including physical education and the successful completion of New York State Regents exams are required for graduation. New York State Regents and Advanced Regents high school diplomas are available. Associates degrees are also attainable through Sullivan County Community College.

REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION: Fallsburg Junior-Senior High School requires a minimum of 22 credits and passing grades on NY State Regents exams for graduation.
