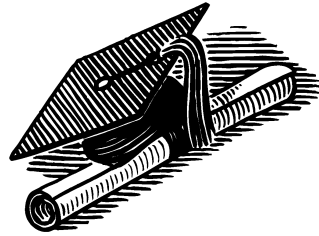


# Marion & Philip Salon \$1000 Memorial Scholarship



## Eligibility and Criteria:

- Scholarship is designated for a graduating senior who has demonstrated a sincere interest in public service, who has participated in meaningful community service activities, or who has overcome a significant personal challenge during his or her school career.
- Student must be planning to attend a four-year college or university beginning in fall 2024.
- Applicants must have attained a strong academic record throughout high school (minimum 85 GPA)
- Upon verification of enrollment at the college or university, the scholarship award will be sent to the institution and credited to the student's account.

## Application Procedure:

- Write a 250-300 word essay describing your involvement in service activities contributing to the betterment of Fallsburg High School or the greater Fallsburg or Sullivan County community and or describing your experience in overcoming a significant personal challenge during your school years. (Include at the end of your essay the name of the college or university you expect to attend.
- A complete high school transcript
- A single letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor or community member with knowledge of the applicant's service commitment or success in overcoming a significant challenge.
- Applications consisting of the above three items must be submitted together to Ms. Vandyke, Guidance Counselor.
- **Deadline: March 14th, 2024**
